There are multitudes of students that are passing through the system and are considered very capable because of their test scores.

Students are very savvy at memorizing and reciting information for a given period of time. Once they have taken the standardized test all of what they have recited and memorized can easily be forgotten.

An effective instructor is going to teach their students to not only know the content being taught, but they will be able to articulate the learning outcomes at any given time once mastered. This means that the instructor will not be able to stand and spew out verbiage that will eventually get lost in translation, due to students mentally checking out after about ten to fifteen minutes.
