These days more and more mobile devices and Internet of Things (IoT) type devices are being used by healthcare professionals to assist in patient care. These devices are more powerful and hold more information than ever before and pose greater risks to the security of your organization.

Covered Entities (CEs) and Business Associates (BAs), who use these devices to create, receive, maintain, or transmit electronic protected health information (ePHI) and must include them in their enterprise-wide risk analysis and take action(s) to reduce risks identified to a reasonable and appropriate level.
