A: To Share a test you've created with another instructor in your program, click on "Manage Tests" from your instructor home page within EMSTesting, and then click "edit test" to the right of the test you'd like to share. When the "Edit Test Settings" page appears, check the box marked "Share this test with other instructors in my school" and then click "Save" on the lower right of the page. This test is now shareable with any other instructor at your institution.
