New Pediatric Age Guidelines - The below age ranges will be used in the future. A toggle will be allowed for reports to allow new ages versus old. A new feature in the future will allow these ages to be used by default but allow programs to adjust the ranges. Also, selection of an age group assessment type will be limited to one assessment age group.

- Newborn: 1 hour to less than 24 hours
- Neonate: 24 hours to 28 days
- Infant: 28+ days to less than 1 year
- Toddler: 1 to less than 3 years
- Preschooler: 3 to less than 6 years
- School Age: 6 to 12 years
- Adolescent: 12+ to 18 years
