Exploring empathy levels among Canadian paramedic students

Empathy is an important factor in communication between healthcare provider and patient. Previous studies have shown that empathy benefits patient care in multiple ways. Empathy allows a space of decreased vulnerability and, as a result, builds trust in healthcare relationships. It fosters open communication that leads to improved patient

care; improves patient satisfaction; and buffers healthcare provider burnout. This study aimed to determine the empathy levels demonstrated by paramedic students to patients with various medical conditions, and to compare these findings with those of previous studies.

Trifecta of EMS Gains on Capitol Hill

NAEMT is pleased to report that the Pandemic and All-Hazards Preparedness and Advancing Innovation Act of 2018 (H.R. 7328) has passed the U.S. House and Senate and has been sent to the President for his signature. This bill would reauthorize certain programs under the Public Health Service Act and the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act with respect to public health security and all-hazards preparedness and response, to clarify the regulatory framework with respect to certain nonprescription drugs that are marketed without an approved drug application, and for other purposes. <u>More details</u>
