



Q: When setting up a class in EMSTesting, what do the different "Grade Type Descriptions" mean? A: In the "Grade Book" tab of a class, there are 5 default categories listed under "Grade Type Descriptions". These are Quiz, Test, Module Exam, Final Exam, and Other. To the right of these categories are "Test Pass %" (which is the score students need to meet to count as "passing") and "% of Grade" (which is the weight of that grade type as a percentage of their overall grade for the class).
