## Ask the Customer Support Team

Q: My student purchased an access code for the wrong provider level from the bookstore (or online vender). Can they still use that to pay their course enrollment fee, or do they need to return it and exchange it for the correct one? A: The answer used to be that students had to return the access code to whoever they purchased it from, as access codes have different values based on the provider level, and based on whether it is an EMSTesting access code or a Platinum Planner access code. There was not a way for a student who purchased an access card of a lower value to apply it to a course of a higher value and then just pay the difference.

# Does your Program need Student Access Cards or Credit?

Many programs still need to gain EMSTesting or Platinum Planner student access. There are three ways students can gain access into our programs:
