

Evaluation of the Elusive Affective Domain

Cognitive, Psychomotor, and Affective are the three domains of learning that we must evaluate as instructors. The cognitive domain focuses on knowledge and is easily evaluated using quizzes and tests. The psychomotor domain focuses on the use of motor skills and can be evaluated by standard skills testing. What about the affective domain? This domain focuses on things like motivation, attitudes, perceptions and core values. As instructors, we are required to objectively

evaluate our students' affect; however, many instructors find it difficult to evaluate a student on what many consider to be subjective criteria. The key to an objective affective evaluation is to evaluate often, use an objective assessment tool and to create opportunities that allow the instructor to observe the student for identified behaviors.

Several years ago, I sat in a meeting of an overdose committee and listened to a woman argue that we should have naloxone in all the middle schools. I am a data person and I pointed out that middle schools are not where people are overdosing. If you only have a limited amount of resources, you want to put those resources where they can do the most good. On the rare occasion, you might need naloxone in a middle school 911 is just minutes away. Police, fire, and EMS all carry it. Someone will be there quickly.

A week ago, a middle schooler (13-years old) in Connecticut died of a fentanyl overdose suffered while in school. There has been a subsequent outcry to require naloxone in schools.

Customer Showcase: Danville Area Training Center (VA)


Every month we give a little bit of love to one of our valued customers! This month we celebrate the awesome EMS Staff at Danville Area Training Center (VA).

The Danville Area Training Center was built in 2004 to fill Danville's void in life support and EMS training. Today, DATC trains thousands of healthcare providers, EMTs and community members each year. They offer courses ranging from First Aid CPR to Pediatric Advanced Life Support and Emergency Medical Technician to Emergency Vehicle Operations. The EMT Basic Training course will prepare you for a career as an emergency medical technician (EMT). You will learn life support, basic patient care and emergency response methods. Upon successful completion of the class, you will earn your EMT certification.

The Danville Area Training Center is essential for training members of the Danville Life Saving Crew, healthcare professionals and community members. Due to the growing need for training in Danville and surrounding areas, DATC began a nearly 4,000 square foot expansion project in mid-2016. Once the remodel was completed in early 2017, DATC instructors were able to offer more classes. Also, due to the expansion, DATC was able to add five new clinical rooms, a conference room, and administrative offices to better serve the community.
