Addressing the Third Leading Cause of Death in the United States

What is the third leading cause of death in the US. Is it cardiovascular disease or cancer? No, those are numbers 1 and 2 respectively killing 614,348 and 591,699 in 2014 per the CDC. Is it COPD or accidents (unintentional injuries)? No, these would be number 4 and 5 respectively killing 147,101, and 136,053 respectively. How about stroke, Alzheimer's

and diabetes? No again, being 6, 7, and 8 respectively killing 133,103, 93,541, and 76,488 in that order. The correct answer, per a report by John Hopkins University, **Medical Errors are the third leading cause of death** in the US killing an estimated 150,000.

Cut Score versus Raw Score Grading

We frequently receive questions concerning the difference between Raw Score and Cut Score grading and which one should be used. This article aims to raise awareness about these methods of reporting students' grades and help the educator decide which one to use with their courses.

What is a Cut Score?

We should begin by defining the term "Cut Score." A cut score, or cut-off score, represents the passing score of a given assessment. It is the minimum score that would indicate that a student possesses proficiency or minimum competency of the content included on the assessment. Simply stated, a cut score is the minimum score that a student must achieve to pass the test (Cut-off score, 2014).

Establishing the passing score, a.k.a. the cut score of an assessment, is known as standard setting. The passing score can be set arbitrarily (Students need an 80% to pass), using norm-referenced grading (grading on a curve), or by using a criterion-based method for establishing cut scores (Cizek, 2012).

The Danville Area Training Center was built in 2004 to fill Danville's void in life support and EMS training. Today, DATC trains thousands of healthcare providers, EMTs and community members each year. They offer courses ranging from First Aid CPR to Pediatric Advanced Life Support and Emergency Medical Technician to Emergency Vehicle Operations. The EMT Basic Training course will prepare you for a career as an emergency medical technician (EMT). You will learn life support, basic patient care and emergency response methods. Upon successful completion of the class, you will earn your EMT certification.

The Danville Area Training Center is essential for training members of the Danville Life Saving Crew, healthcare professionals and community members. Due to the growing need for training in Danville and surrounding areas, DATC began a nearly 4,000 square foot expansion project in mid-2016. Once the remodel was completed in early 2017, DATC instructors were able to offer more classes. Also, due to the expansion, DATC was able to add five new clinical rooms, a conference room, and administrative offices to better serve the community.
