Update on our Test Banks – June 2022

We have been working hard to create and enter new technology-enhanced items (TEIs) into our testing bank. All new items are introduced as pilot items during computer adaptive testing (CAT) experiences. Your students have seen the new TEI item types as they complete their CAT experiences. **Pilot items are not factored into the student's results. The pilot process allows us to collect the item validation data to ensure**

that each item performs adequately before being released into the primary bank. If you do not want your students exposed to the pilot questions, you can disable the item piloting feature by editing your school settings. Contact Customer Support if you require assistance with this.
