Utilizing Platinum Educational Group with the CARES Act

The US Department of Education has made available funds for both students and institutions as a direct result of the COVID-19 Pandemic. There are roughly \$6.2 billion dollars still available under

the Emergency Relief Fund for all Title IV Higher Education Institutions.

Only 50% of institutions have completed the application process for their students to date. The DOE is not requiring students to track how they use their emergency financial aid grants nor requiring institutions to report how students use their grants. $\hat{a} \in \mathbb{C}$ The DOE also reiterated the emergency financial aid grants are $\hat{a} \in \mathbb{C}$ and can be distributed to students through a pre-loaded debit card, credit card, or by check; however, these grants cannot be applied to a student $\hat{a} \in \mathbb{C}$ institutional account. $\hat{a} \in \mathbb{C}$ (CECU April 2020)
