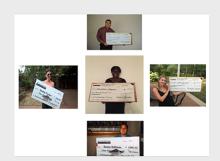

subcontractors, to ensure appropriate safeguards are implemented to protect Protected Health Information (PHI) and electronic PHI (ePHI).

How does "sign up by start date" work?

Q: How do "Sign Up By Start Date" and "Sign Up By End Date" work when I am setting up my students' opportunities?

A: The "Sign Up By End Date" lets you set the minimum number of days in advance a student can sign up for an opportunity. Entering the number "7" would mean that students can sign up for an opportunity no less than 7 days before it is scheduled. Entering a negative number, like "-20", means that students have to sign up for this opportunity no later than the 20th of the previous month. Entering a specific date, such as "12/15/2021", means that students must sign up for this

opportunity by that specific date.

Customer Showcase: Columbus State Community College(OH)

Every month we give a little bit of love to one of our valued customers! This month we celebrate the awesome staff at **Columbus State Community College (OH).**

Columbus State Community College (CSCC) is a public community college in Columbus, Ohio. Founded as Columbus Area Technician's School in 1963, it was renamed Columbus Technical

Institute in 1965 and was renamed again to its current name in 1987. The college has grown from an initial enrollment of 67 students in 1963 to its current enrollment of over 27,000 students over two campuses, nine regional learning centers, and online courses.

The 70-acre Columbus campus is located near downtown Columbus, Ohio. It consists of 26 buildings and was previously the site of Aquinas College High School. In addition, Columbus State operates 6 off-campus centers in the suburban neighborhoods of Dublin, Westerville, Marysville, Grove City, Reynoldsburg, and southwest Columbus.

The college has built a new 106-acre satellite campus in Liberty Township of southern Delaware County. The first building was completed in 2010. The new building can accommodate 2,500-3,017 students. In 2011, Columbus State partnered with The Ohio State University to allow students and faculty from both schools to work out of the new facility.

The College's Strategic Plan evolved from comprehensive planning sessions involving several hundred faculty, staff, and administrators. This process engaged our entire community including a cross-section of alumni and regional leaders. Three priorities — Student Success, Workforce Development, and Civic Engagement — dominated the conversation, and dedicated workgroups were charged with developing priorities and practical initiatives for each goal.

We want to thank them for their trust in our solutions, their trust in our customer service, and for their trust in our reputation to provide the highest quality of both!
