Passwords and Passphrases

The Administrative <u>Safeguards</u> of the HIPAA Security Rule requires <u>Covered Entities</u> (CEs) and <u>Business Associates</u> (BAs) to: Implement procedures for creating, changing and safeguarding passwords.

- Make sure you create and regularly use strong passwords (i.e. usually 10 characters or more and includes uppercase and lowercase letters, numbers, and special characters like #\$&*).
- When creating your passwords, consider using unique "passphrases," which are sentences that may be easier to remember than a very complex password e.g. "I got A new bike for my 8th birthday!" would be ItAwkry8b!
- Do NOT use passwords or phrases that would be easy to guess, such as a pet's name or your birth date.

Q: How Do I Change/Add/Remove Skill Requirements on My Course and Classes? A: Course requirements are editable settings on both the course and its individual classes. A class can only enable skills of its class type (lab, clinical, etc.) that are already enabled on the course. If a skill is missing from a class but isn't an option to enable on that class, this means it is not enabled on the course first. So, if lab class needs 'skill b' enabled, but has no option for it, you just have to edit the course skill requirements and add

it there, then add it to the lab class. This new skill will now be selectable by students during labs for that class.

Every Month we give a little bit of love to one of our valued customers! This month we celebrate the awesome nursing education staff at Auburn Career Center.


