Parting Thoughts

Learning from Failure

As the Client Relations Manager at Platinum, I contact each of our clients at least four times per year, to offer assistance and to ensure our clients are enjoying our software. During these conversations in 2015-17, some of our clients indicated they will not renew their annual licenses to use our software, due to site or EMS program closures, from financial issues, political, or other reasons. In 2017, so far three clients in three states, explained their EMS educational programs were directed to another institution, as theirs were closed or closing. Although not said specifically, my impression was the EMS educational program had failed for two of them.

As I was researching why EMS programs fail, I ran across an article that offers hope for EMS failures.* The article was written by Chris Cebollero in November 2015, and it offers advice for a mindset change of embracing the failure to learn from it and to move on. The article focuses on growing from the experience and applying learned lessons to the next situation, to succeed. As a very brief summary, according to Cebollero, there are five steps for accepting and moving on from failure:

- 1. Understand failure is not personal**
- 2. Learn from mistakes**
- 3. Let it go**
- 4. Don't be judged**
- 5. Embrace the human**

Although the article title refers to EMS Failures, it is obvious that the advice can be applied to any aspect of life, not just an EMS failure, including career changes, relationship challenges, poor decisions, etc. I recommend reading the article and applying its advice to your personal and EMS lives.
