Episode 36: Know The Rules! Why Security is Important in Healthcare?

Everyone working in healthcare knows about the privacy side of the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) but there is also a security side too!

The Privacy Rule sets the standards for, among other things, who may have access to electronic protected health information (ePHI). While the Security Rule sets the standards for ensuring only those who should have access to ePHI will actually have that access.

The Privacy Rule also requires Covered Entities (CEs), and in certain circumstances their Business Associates (BAs), to have in place appropriate Administrative, Physical, and technical safeguards and to implement those safeguards reasonably. When Health & Human Services (HHS) developed the Security Rule, they chose to closely follow their requirements in the Privacy Rule.

Every month we give a little bit of love to one of our valued customers! This month we celebrate the awesome **Dental Staff at Indian Hills Community College (IA)**

Merged Area XV Community College adopted the name "Indian Hills Community College" in 1970. Dr. Mel Everingham, who was named president of Merged Area XV Community College two years before, stayed on as the first president of Indian Hills Community College. A historical pavilion, containing photographs and other memorabilia and named for Dr. Everingham, was added in the Advanced

Dr. Lyle Hellyer became the college's president in 1973 and would remain in that position until his retirement in 2001. Dr. Jim Lindenmayer became the college's third president following Dr. Hellyer's retirement. In 2013, Dr. Marlene Sprouse became the fourth president of Indian Hills Community College.

The program in Dental Hygiene is accredited by the Commission on Dental Accreditation (CODA). The Commission is a specialized accrediting body recognized by the United States Department of Education. Graduates will become employed in private dentist's offices, public health agencies, community health offices, hospitals, and schools. Upon successful completion, students are awarded Associate of Applied Science degrees in Dental Hygiene. Graduates of the program will be eligible to sit for the National Board Dental Hygiene (NBDHE) and clinical board exam CRDTS.
