Ask the Customer Support Team

Q: When creating a class in Platinum Planner, what is the difference between a "Lecture" class, a "Lab" class, and a "Lab and Lecture" class? A: Lecture classes are primarily created to block off when students are supposed to be in class for lecture. When creating a Lecture class there is a tab called "Schedule". This tab will let you select which days of the week class takes place, the location where class will occur on that day, and when class begins and ends on that day.

Lab classes allow you to set lab skill requirements for students. For that particular class you can decide which skills that have been activated for the course can be tracked for lab sessions associated with this class and what the minimum requirements are to complete the class. You can also assign individual instructors to the class, which will determine who has the ability to create individual lab sessions and who can review student lab documentation.
