

According to psychologist James Deese¹, a certain level of understanding needs to occur in order to reach interpretation. When communicating with others, we often think of words. However, according to

Dr. Dustin York, an Assistant Professor of Communication at Maryville University in Missouri, 93 percent of communication is nonverbal². If the overwhelming majority of what is communicated is without words, then it is essential to understand, and appreciate, how nonverbal communication contributes to effective communication. This is especially true in the learning environment, as research suggests nonverbal messages are often more significant in student learning than formal instruction³.
