Why Are EMS Professionals Desperately Needed In Rural Areas?

According to the National Rural Health Association, across the United States, about 57 million people, or 18% of the total population, call rural communities' home. Rural EMS services are more dependent on volunteers than their urban counterparts. A national survey of local EMS directors in rural and urban areas finds rural agencies were more

likely to be staffed by volunteers only, (53% for isolated small rural vs. 14% for urban, see Figure 3). In some rural parts of the country (tending to be those more sparsely populated) it is estimated that volunteers cover more than 90 percent of EMS calls.

Explanation of Cut Score Versus Raw Score Evaluation (Grading) Scales

Platinum Educational Group is often asked to explain what a cut score is and how the student's "cut score" is calculated and why it is so different from the raw score. Provided below is the answer to that question as well as some other information and definitions.

Definitions

Raw Score-The actual score, represented as a decimal or percent showing how many items the student answered correctly divided by the total number of items on the examination.

Published Passing Score-Also known as a published cut score is set by an institution and represents the minimum percentage a student must achieve to pass the examination (aka-make the cut).
