The Scholarly Column-Bloom's Taxonomy

Why should I incorporate this model into my teaching methods?

In 1948, psychologist Benjamin Bloom, along with his peers, created Bloom's Taxonomy.

- Taxonomy is a classification into ordered categories.
- Eponyms is word based on or derived from a person's name.

In academia, Bloom's Taxonomy is often used by educational institutions and educators across the board. This framework is a tool that acts as an aid in the learner's comprehension of concepts that are introduced in the classroom. The premise of this hierarchical model is to start at the bottom and to work up to the top. In this article, medical terminology is used to illustrate how this model can work.

who enrolled for the first semester in 1963 to more than 40,000 learners.

The Veterinary Technology program at Mesa Community College is a rigorous and challenging AVMA-accredited program and provides instruction in small animal, large animal, and laboratory animal medical and surgical nursing, laboratory techniques, office protocol, emergency medicine, specialty medicine, and other topics.

Instruction also includes practical clinical internship experience in veterinary emergency, large animal, small animal, and specialty practices, as well as in zoos, laboratories, humane societies, and other facilities.

The curriculum combines courses in animal science and animal health with a general education component. Upon completion of the program, the student will be awarded an Associate in Applied Science in Veterinary Technology degree. Graduates from the program are eligible to sit for the Veterinary Technician National Exam (VTNE) to become certified.
