The Health Information Technology for Economic and Clinical Health (HITECH) Act, enacted as part of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, was signed into law on February 17, 2009, to promote the adoption and meaningful use of health

information technology. (1) Mainly, this Act strengthens enforcement of HIPPA rules. (2) It allows The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) to impose civil money penalties for violations occurring after Feb. 18, 2009.

Calhoun Community College prides itself in EMS! They boast the largest EMS program in Alabama with more than 200 EMS graduates per year! Even their Dean, Bret McGill, has an EMS background! For the past 3 years Calhoun has had an NREMT pass rate of 100%! But, what really sets them apart is there accelerated Paramedic Program.

In 2008, Calhoun queried the top 100 nursing students that did not make the cut to look at the option of Paramedic. Since these students already had generic credits (24 are required for this accelerated program), they could become a Paramedic in just 12 months! The pilot course had 79 participants!
